Shower Screens

- 1. Fixed Panel: Average 1200mm- \$900 2. Inline Hinged: Average 900mm \$1200 \$1600

- To ensure that no ponding or leaking occurs in the base we recommend that the fall to the waste be a minimum of 15mm over a standard 1000mm base.
- 100mm wide solid framing is required for fixing wall mounted doors. Head bracing in the form of a 6mm clear toughened glass panel over the door is required for many situations.
- Shower rose position: All efforts should be made during design to ensure that the shower rose is not positioned directly opposite the screen door.

- 3. Fix and Swing: Average 900mm- \$11004. Inline slider: Average 1200mm-\$18005. Corner Hinged: Av. 900mm x 900mm \$1600 \$2000

- To ensure that no ponding or leaking occurs in the base we recommend that the fall to the waste be a minimum of 15mm over a standard 1000mm base.
- 100mm wide solid framing is required for fixing wall mounted doors. Head bracing in the form of a 6mm clear toughened glass panel over the door is required for many situations.
- Shower rose position: All efforts should be made during design to ensure that the shower rose is not positioned directly opposite the screen door.

- 6. Corner Slider: Average 1200mm x \$900mm- \$2200.00 7. Euroglide Inline: Avarege 1300mm- \$2500 8. Euroglide: Average 1300mm x 900mm- \$2800

- To ensure that no ponding or leaking occurs in the base we recommend that the fall to the waste be a minimum of 15mm over a standard 1000mm base.
- 100mm wide solid framing is required for fixing wall mounted doors. Head bracing in the form of a 6mm clear toughened glass panel over the door is required for many situations.
- Shower rose position: All efforts should be made during design to ensure that the shower rose is not positioned directly opposite the screen door.



Average price for 10m pool fence not inc gate: \$4000 - \$6000

All glass is placed on stainless steel pegs at a minimum height of 1200mm from all finished surfaces.

Advantages:

- The fence has no effect of drainage of water.
- Leaves and debris simple blow under the fence instead of sitting against the glass.
- The fence is the last item to be installed reducing the risk of other trades damaging your product during the construction period.

- 90(h) x 120(W) solid continual beam is to be prepared by the main contractor
- · Kiln dried hardwood beam is recommended to minimise movement in structure.
- · Posts are surface mounted with 4 x stainless steel bugle screws or threaded rod chemset into foundation * Conditions apply, see page
- 26.



Glass is cantilevered on 50 diameter stainless steel anchors. 10,15, 20, 30, 40 or 50mm anchor body lengths are available.

Advantages:

- Attached to the side of walls, decking's, planter box's
- Eliminates the 10mm step rule so glass can remain at 1200mm
- Contemporary stainless steel method

- Min 250mm overhang of glass is required
- Anchors are either chemset into concrete, bolted to timber or tapped into steel beams
- When timber is used a kiln dried hardwood beam is recommended to minimise movement in structure.
- * Conditions apply, see page 26.



Glass is cantilevered from a aluminium base channel set in the decking.

Advantages:

- Elegant & stylish design offering clean lines with unobstructed views of your swimming pool
- Easily prepared method
- No visible fixings just glass erecting out the decking

- 90 x 90 solid continual recess is to be prepared by the main contractor
- Kiln dried hardwood 90 x 90 beam is recommended to minimise movement in structure.
- Glass is then installed in the channel and filled with construction grade non shrink grout
- * Conditions apply, see page 26.



Average price for 10m pool fence not inc gate: \$4000 - \$6000

Glass is cantilevered on mini stainless steel pegs. All panels are to be a minimum height of 1200mm from all finished surfaces (tiles, pavers, garden beds, decking, planter boxes .etc) This includes a 20-50mm gap under the glass and between panels.

Advantages:

- The fence has no effect on the drainage of water
- Leaves and debris simply blow under the fence instead of sitting against the glass
- The fence is the last item to be installed reducing the risk of other trades damaging your product during the construction period
- Currently the most popular method of frameless fencing

- A minimum concrete depth of 200mm is required.
- 60 diameter holes are core drilled to a depth of 110mm down from FFL.
- Core drilling must be set in a min of 120mm.

Pre Formed Concrete Pool Fence


Average price for 10m pool fence not inc gate: \$4500

Glass is cantilevered from a pre formed concrete footing prepared by the main contractor.

Advantages:

- Elegant and stylish design offering clean lines with unobstructed views of your swimming pool
- The most economical method of frameless pool fencing
- Minimum preparation required

- A pre-formed concrete channel 50mm x 100mm is to be prepared by the main contractor. Ref to diagram for a guide.
- •Glass is then installed in the concrete channel and filled with construction grade non shrink grout.
- Drainage must be considered when selecting this method of fencing.
- Water can retain against glass.





Glass is cantilevered on mini stainless steel pegs 1000mm from all finished surfaces (tiles, pavers, decking, planter boxes .etc)

Advantages:

- The Balustrade has no effect on the drainage of water
- Leaves, debris and water simply filter under the glass
- The Balustrade is the last item to be installed reducing the risk of other trades damaging your product during the construction period

- the main contractor
- Kiln dried hardwood 90 x 90 beam or steel is recommended to minimize movement in structure.
- Glass is then installed in the channel and filled with construction grade non shrink grout
- * Conditions apply, see page 26.



Hidden Base Channel Balustrade

Average price for 10m balustrade, not including handrail: \$7000

Glass is cantilevered from an aluminium base channel set in the decking. All panels are to be a minimum height of 100mm from all finished surfaces (tiles, pavers, decking, and planter boxes .etc). Glass widths vary from 1200mm-2200mm with 20-50mm gaps between panels.

Advantages

- Elegant & stylish design offering clean lines with unobstructed views
- Easily prepared method
- No visible fixings just glass erecting out the sub straight (handrail is required)

- 90 x 90 solid continual recess is to be prepared by the main contractor
- Kiln dried hardwood 90 x 90 beam or steel is recommended to minimize movement in structure.
- · Glass is then installed in the channel and filled with construction grade non shrink grout
- * Conditions apply, see page 26.



Glass is cantilevered on 50 diameter stainless steel anchors.10,15, 20, 30, 40 or 50mm anchor body lengths are available. All panels are to be a minimum height of 1000mm from all finished surfaces (tiles, pavers, decking, planter boxes .etc)

Advantages:

- Attached to the face of balconies and stairs
- The most versatile balustrade system
- Contemporary stainless steel method

- Min 250mm overhang of glass is required
- Anchors are either chemset into concrete, bolted to timber or tapped into steel beams
- When timber is used a kiln dried hardwood beam is recommended to minimise movement in structure.


